Subject: CyberTax 2009-29: UPDATE: TaxWise 2008 Post Season Release CD

On July 7, 2009, we sent out a message notifying you of a possible virus on the Post Season Release of the TaxWise CD. The IRS and CCH have verified that the file is NOT a virus. The file was used to fix the multiple drive issue that some sites experienced last year. CCH has declared it safe to load the CD and apologized for any inconvenience this may have caused. AVG has also updated their virus definitions (Virus DB 270.13.17/2242 or later) and they no longer report a potential virus in the "tw08odbc.exe" file on the TaxWise 2008 Post Season CD.

Thank you all for your vigilance and patience.
