**Your bank and credit card companies:** Copy the front and back of your credit cards and keep the copies in a safe place!

**Do not carry your Social Security Card in your wallet.**

Unless you have a medical appointment, you don't need to constantly carry your original Medicare card or any card with your Social Security number in your wallet. Instead, **make a copy of your Medicare card and cross the number off of the copy.** Keep the letters A or B that are on the card, and then put the copy into your wallet. Keep your original Medicare card in a safe place at home so that you can pick it up when you have a medical appointment.

**NEVER** give personal or financial information to anyone unless you initiate the contact and know for certain it is the right number.
