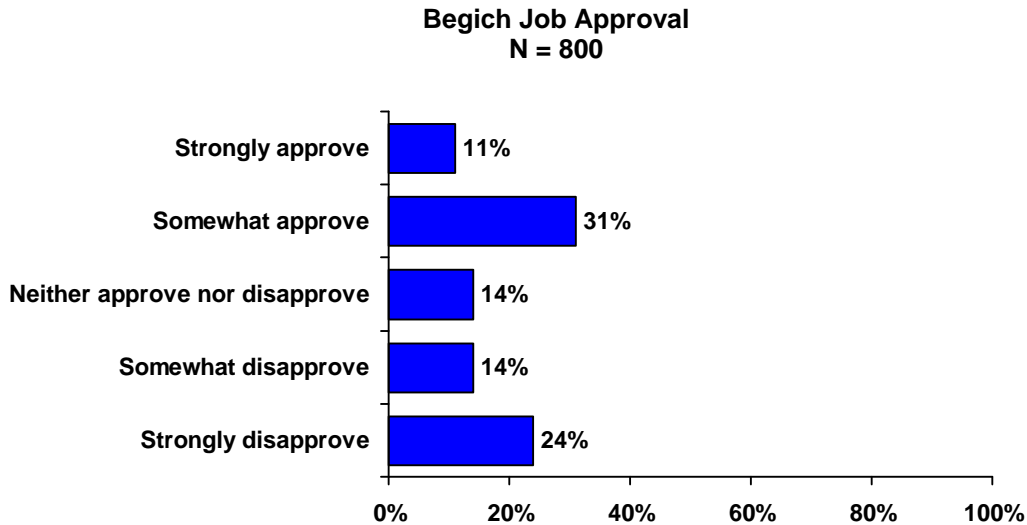


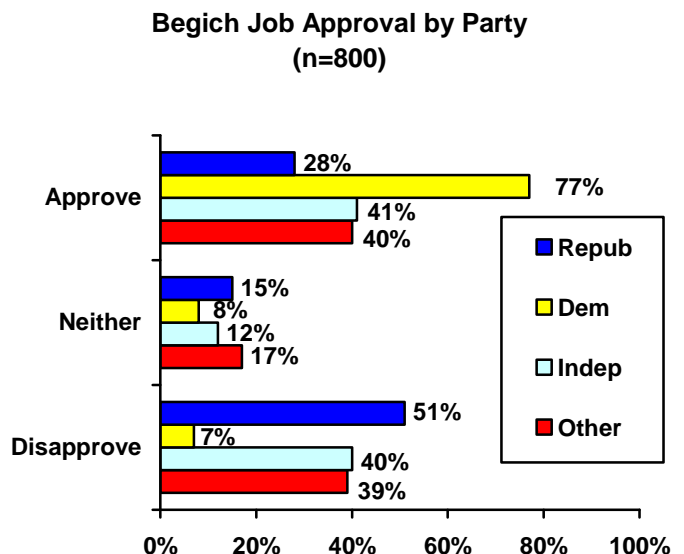
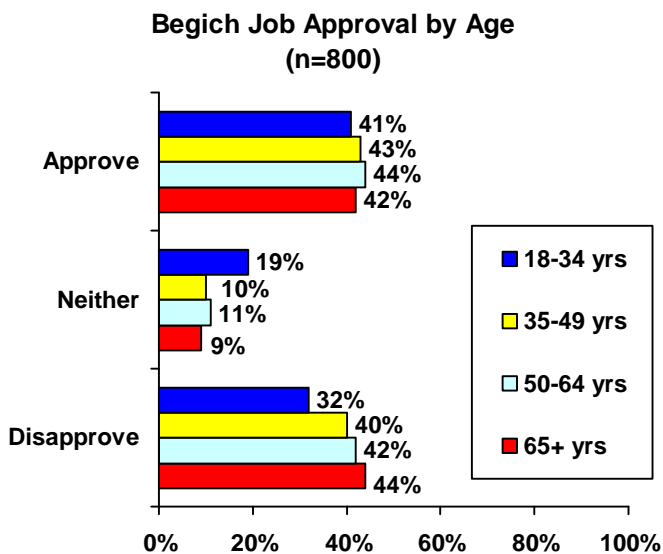
**Opinion About Senator Mark Begich**

➤ **Forty-two percent of Alaskans approve of the job Senator Mark Begich is doing.**



Alaskans ages 18-34 are significantly more likely to neither approve nor disapprove of the job Sen. Begich is doing than those who are 35 and older. Alaskans 65 and older are significantly more likely to disapprove of the job Sen. Begich is doing than those 18-34.

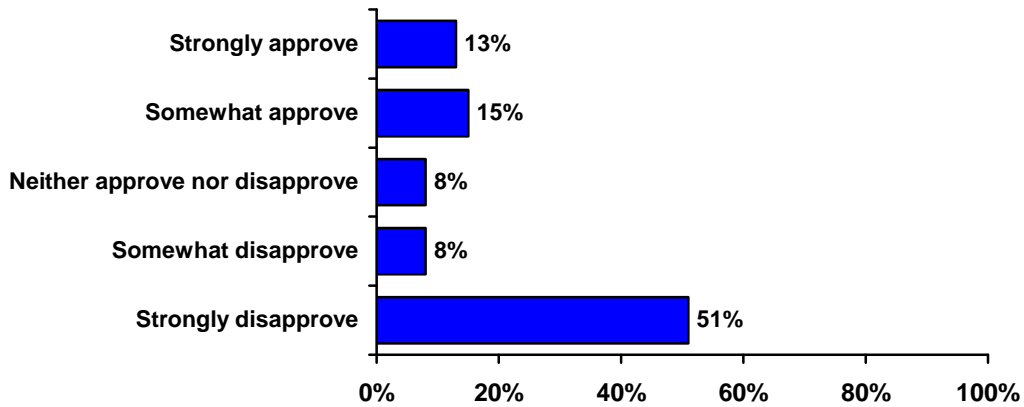
Alaska Democrats and Independents are significantly more likely to approve of the job Sen. Begich is doing than Republicans. Republicans, Independents, and Others are significantly more likely to disapprove of the job Sen. Begich is doing than Democrats.



**Opinion About Health Care Reform**

- Six in ten Alaskans disapprove of the current health care reform legislation being considered in Congress.

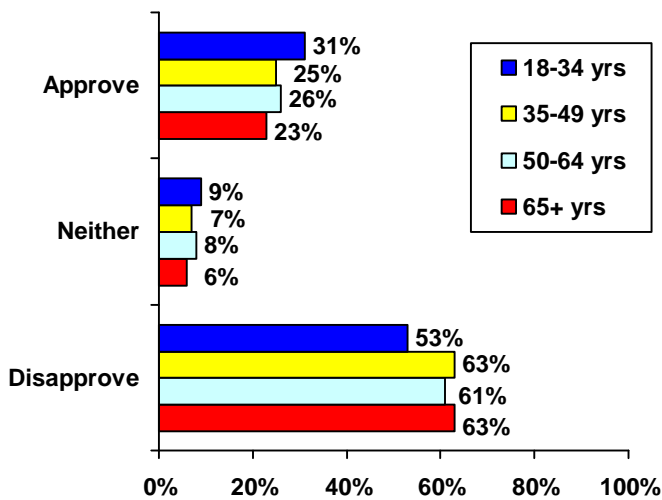
Health Care Reform Legislation Approval

There are no significant age differences among Alaskans regarding approval or disapproval of Congressional health care reform legislation.

Alaska Democrats are significantly more likely to approve of current Congressional health care reform legislation than Republicans, Independents, or Others. Republicans are significantly more likely to disapprove of current Congressional health care reform legislation than Democrats, Independents, or Others.
